PARK PERMIT ISSUED WITH THE FOLLOWING UNDERSTANDING

In accepting this permit it is understood and agreed that in consideration for being granted access to and the use of the equipment, property, and facilities of the City of Buffalo, the permit holder assumes any and all risk with respect to such access and use, and hereby releases the City of Buffalo, its representatives, agents, servants, and employees and third parties maintaining, managing, and/or operating City Parks and Park Facilities, from liability for any injuries sustained or damage incurred in the course of such access and use resulting from any cause whatsoever which may be sustained.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE BELOW RULES AND POSTED PARK REGULATIONS MAY RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF THIS PERMIT AND ANY FUTURE REQUESTS FOR PERMITS.

HOURS

Sunrise to 10:00 p.m.

PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS

Drugs

Illegal drugs or paraphernalia are not allowed.

Conduct & Behavior

Disorderly conduct of any type is prohibited.

Fire Arms

Carrying or discharging of firearms is prohibited.

Noise & Music

Unreasonably loud noise or music is prohibited.

Fires

Fires shall be allowed only in grills.

Dogs

Dogs must be licensed and kept on a leash.

Gambling

Gambling is prohibited.

Alcoholic Beverages

Alcoholic beverages are not allowed.

Commercial Enterprises

Commercial enterprises are prohibited without a permit issued by the Deputy Commissioner of Parks & Recreation.

Parking

Only in designed parking areas. Illegally parked vehicles on grass or play areas will be towed.

Orders of Police and Park Officials

Park patrons shall comply with the lawful orders of police officers and park officials.

Transference & Validity

All permits are non-transferable and valid only for the facilities, areas, dates, times, persons, and/or organizations specified.

NOTE: The City of Buffalo and any third party operating, maintaining, or managing City Parks or Park Facilities are absolved from responsibility when personnel of the City or personnel of third parties operating, maintaining, or managing City Parks or Park Facilities are not in supervision of areas covered by this permit. **NO PERMIT HOLDER NOR HIS/HER/THEIR REPRESENTATIVE OR ASSOCIATES HAS THE RIGHT TO ADVERTISE THEIR EVENT IN ANY CITY PARK OR PARK FACILITY BY WAY OF HANGING FLYERS OR POSTERS IN CITY PARKS OR PARK FACILITIES NOR BY ANY OTHER MEANS INVOLVING USE OF CITY PROPERTY.**

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

CLEAN-UP PROVISIONS

EACH GROUP GRANTED A PERMIT FOR PARK USE IS DIRECTLY RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEAN-UP IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THEIR EVENT. PERMIT HOLDERS NOT COMPLYING WITH CLEAN-UP PROVISIONS WILL NOT BE ISSUED FUTURE PERMITS.
